## Introduction

SADIL-TOGO is a non-governmental, non-profit organization in Togo (West Africa). The organization aims to guide the most vulnerable children and young people in Central Togo to a successful adult life and to improve the general health in the local community.

SADIL-TOGO (in Togo) is based in Tchamba and focuses on the population in rural and semi-urban areas in Central Togo. A local team of employees works on a daily basis to improve the conditions for the most vulnerable children and the local community.

Stichting SADIL-TOGO in the Netherlands tries to raise funds for the work in Togo. After assessment against the policy plan and the applicable ANBI requirements, the funds are allocated to the projects and SADIL-TOGO (in Togo) is responsible for the implementation of the projects in Togo. In this context, the foundation in the Netherlands works together with SADIL-TOGO in Togo.

## Explanatory notes to the annual accounts

In 2024, Stichting SADIL-TOGO was established to support the work of SADIL-TOGO in Togo. In November 2024, the foundation received ANBI status retroactively as per July 2024.

During the first few months, focus was mostly on setting up the Dutch entity and taking first steps in fundraising for the work in Togo. These are the first financial accounts that are due (accounts of the years 2024 and 2025).

### *Income*

As can be seen from the overviews, fundraising in 2025 significantly picked up due to grants received from organizations such as McKinsey for Children, Stichting Talent and Stichting Mundo Crastino Meliori. In addition, a stable group of individual sponsors have been transferring monthly donations to support children in the program. Several fundraising drives were organized to raise funds.

### *General expenses*

Operating expenses for Stichting SADIL-TOGO in the Netherlands have been minimal. Apart from banking fees and running the website, only a membership fee to UICN was paid. Most other income has been allocated to projects in Togo and a large share of this was paid out.

## Results of Stichting SADIL-TOGO in 2025

Income allocated to programs in Togo have been spent on both the Education Pour Tous and Université Pour Tous programs. Specifically:

- Education Pour Tous – 205 children supported in primary and secondary school, of which 95% passed exams and progressed to the next level
- Université Pour Tous – 3 students supported with tertiary education scholarships

Furthermore, a small contribution has been made to staff salaries in SADIL-TOGO, as well as a contribution to the office space.
